- Never take candy, money, or a gift from a stranger.
- Never take alcohol, cigarettes or other drugs from anyone.
- Always walk and play with a friend.
- Always look both ways before you cross the street.
- Never agree to meet anyone you talk to on the internet.
- Never play with matches.
- Never run with sharp objects.
- Never play with guns. Even if you think it is a play gun, it could be real.

If you feel unsafe or uneasy, find a trusted adult, like a police officer or deputy, or call 9-1-1.

911 Safety Tips

- Never say "nine eleven". Since there is no eleven on the phone keypad, children can become confused in an emergency situation. Always say 911!



Call 9-1-1 in any emergency!

- Always call 911 from a safe place. If there is a fire in the house, get to a safe place before you call 911.
- Know your address-have it posted near the phone. Adults have been known to forget their address and phone number during an emergency, so make it easy for everyone in the home.
- Never call 911 as a joke or prank. You could get into trouble, your parents could get into trouble and you could keep someone who really needs help from getting it.
- 911 is for people, NOT animals. If you have a problem with a pet, call a friend or veterinarian.
- If you are not sure if you have an emergency, call 911 and explain your problem to the 911 dispatcher.
- If you call 911 by accident, please do not hang up. When the dispatcher answers, explain that you called 911 by mistake and that you do not have an emergency.

911 Basics

When you should call 911:

- In an emergency
- When you need help
- When you need the police, fire department, or an ambulance

How you call 911:

- Stay calm
- Listen for a dial tone
- On a push button phone, push 9 -1-1



What to say when the 911 dispatcher answers:

- Explain what is wrong-what type of emergency is it
- Explain what type of help you need-police, fire, ambulance
- Explain where help is needed
- Give your name and address loudly and clearly
- Answer all questions that are asked of you

*Hello Operator?
Can you give me
the number to 911?*

What NOT to do when you call 911:

- Do not nod your head, but answer "yes" or "no" out loud
- Do not hang up until the dispatcher says it's ok to do so

When you should NOT call 911:

- When there is no emergency
- For animals
- As a game or prank
- As a joke
- To practice

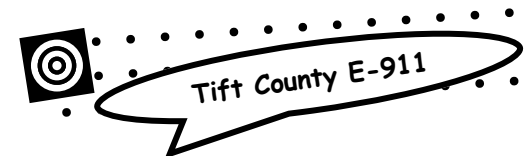
